## Guidelines for admission to the MSc in Economics and Business Administration for applicants with a professional bachelor's degree (professionsbachelorer)

To be eligible for admission to the MSc programmes, applicants with a professional bachelor's degree must *either* have completed specific elective courses as part of their qualifying exam *or* pass supplementary courses of 20-30 ECTS from the BSc in Economics and Business Administration. In the following tables, the requirements for elective courses and supplementary courses are laid out. All supplementary courses are offered during the spring semester in both Danish and English.
