- Scholarship letter (1 week acceptance deadline)

### MSc in Economics and Business Administration

If you are applying to the MSc in Economics and Business Administration, the reply to your application will be sent between 1 November and early March. However, all letters regarding scholarships and tuition fees are sent out in early March.

### Deadline for accepting your (conditional) admission offer.

After this date, you will receive your tuition fee invoice. Once we have received your tuition fee payment, you will receive your study permit application form (ST1).
